



Field Reference for the Snoqualmie Valley Ear-tagged Elk

As of April 2011 there are 22 ear-tagged elk in the Snoqualmie Valley. Each elk is distinguished by ear tag color, left or right ear, collar or no collar. Where these are the same the elk are distinguished by the number on the ear tag. If you see one of the ear-tagged elk and would like to report your find please file your report with Mr. Harold Erland write to research@snoqualmievalleyelk.org or call 425-698-3180. Please note the date, time, exact location, ear tag color, which ear the tag is in (left/right) and the collar color.
